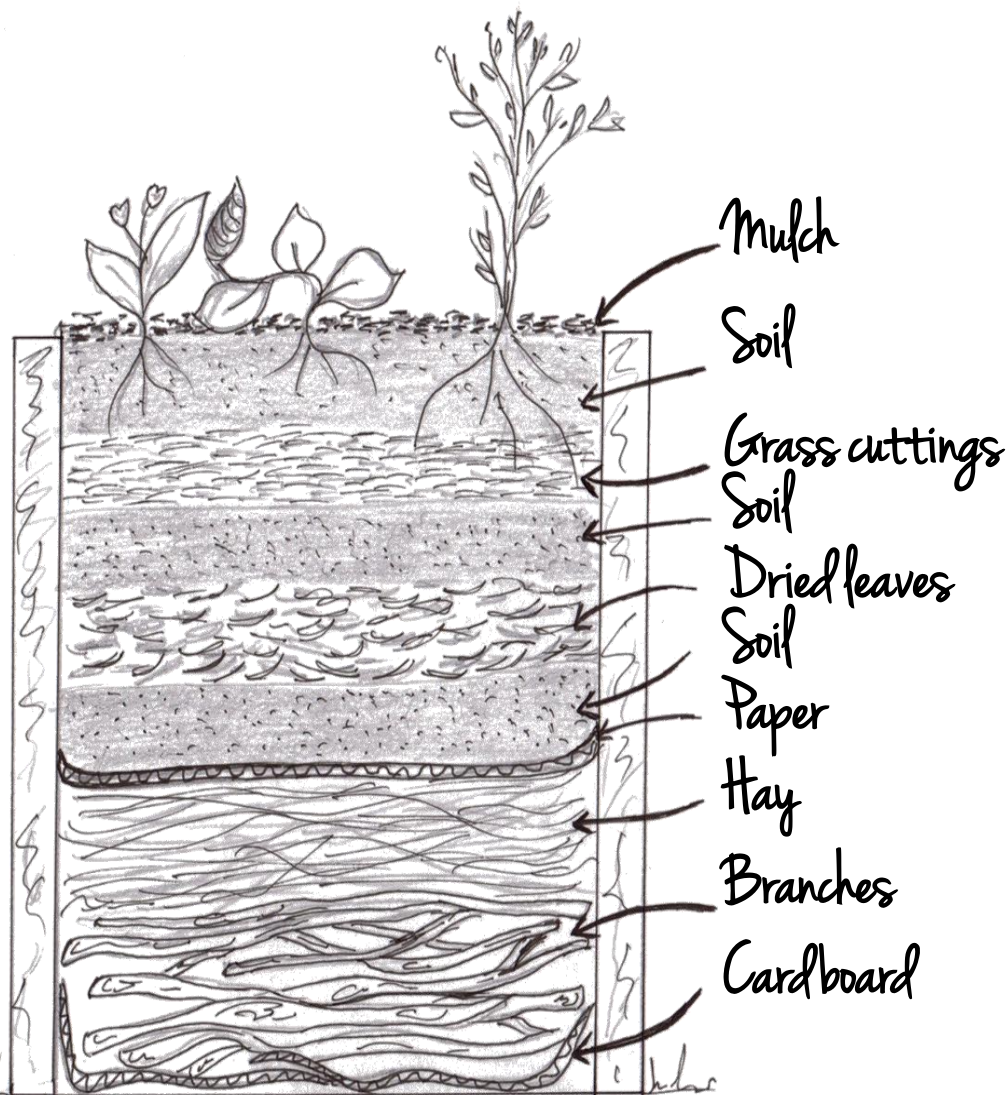


What's in the beds? Step by step



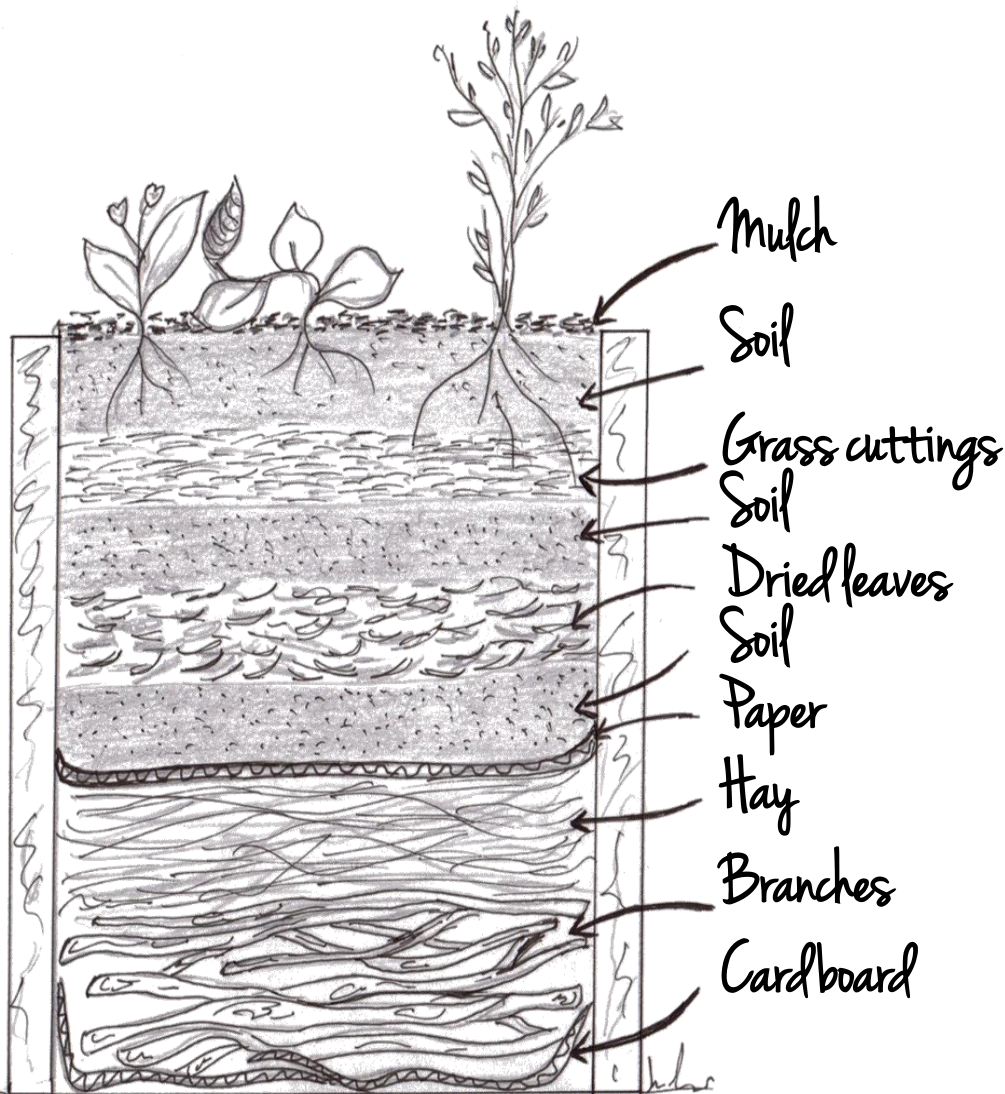
We used a permaculture design to fill our beds with layers of several materials. They will decompose at different speed and give nutrients to the plants for a long time.

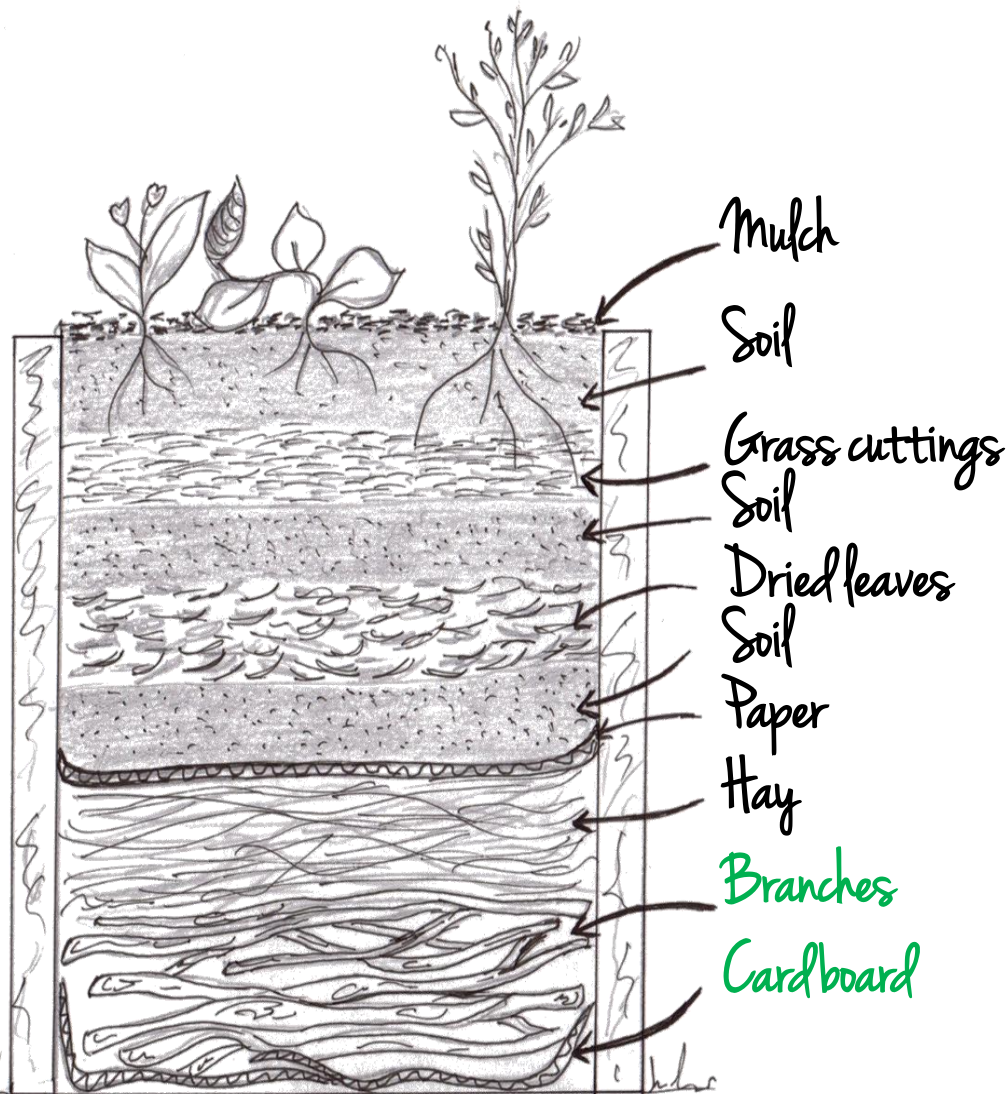

1. Build the raised beds



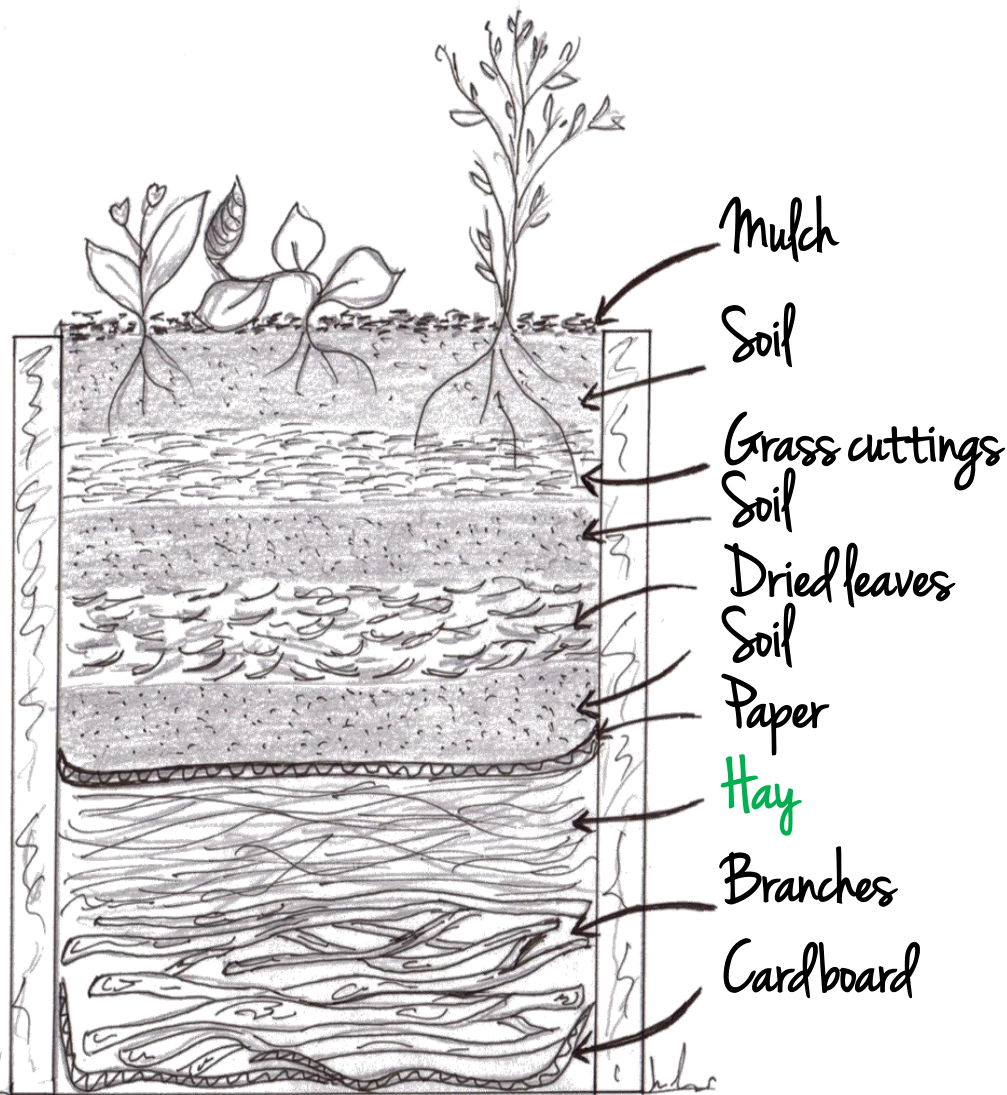

2. Cardboard and branches at the bottom



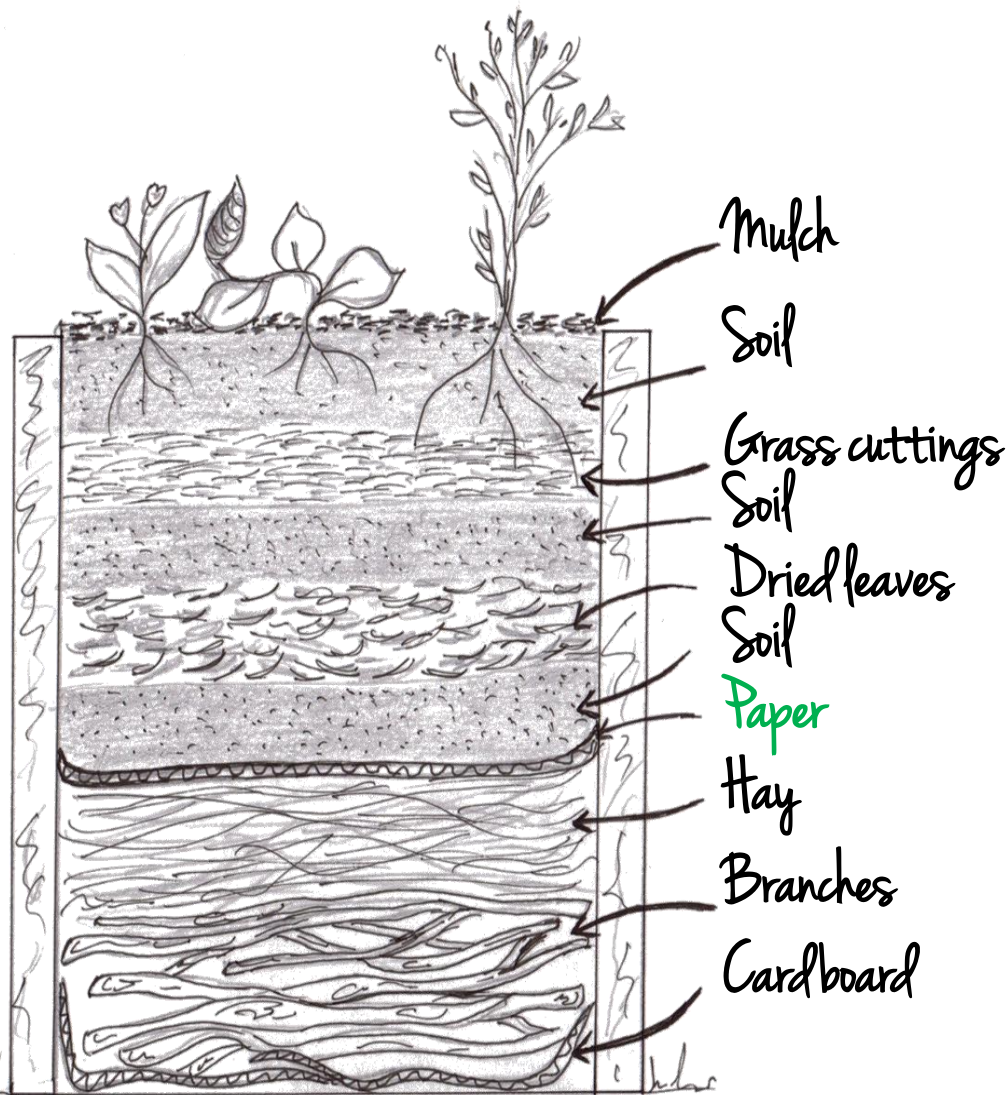

3. A layer of hay

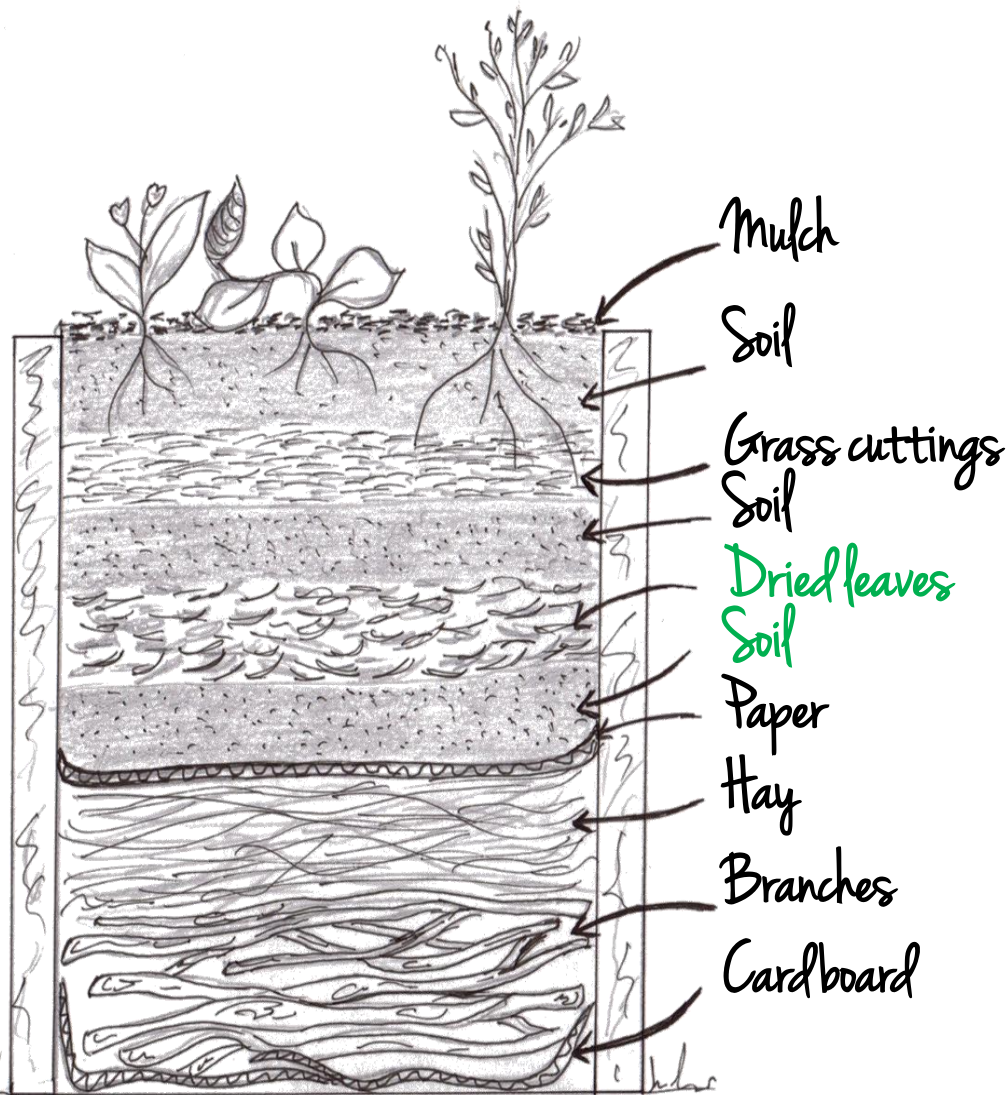

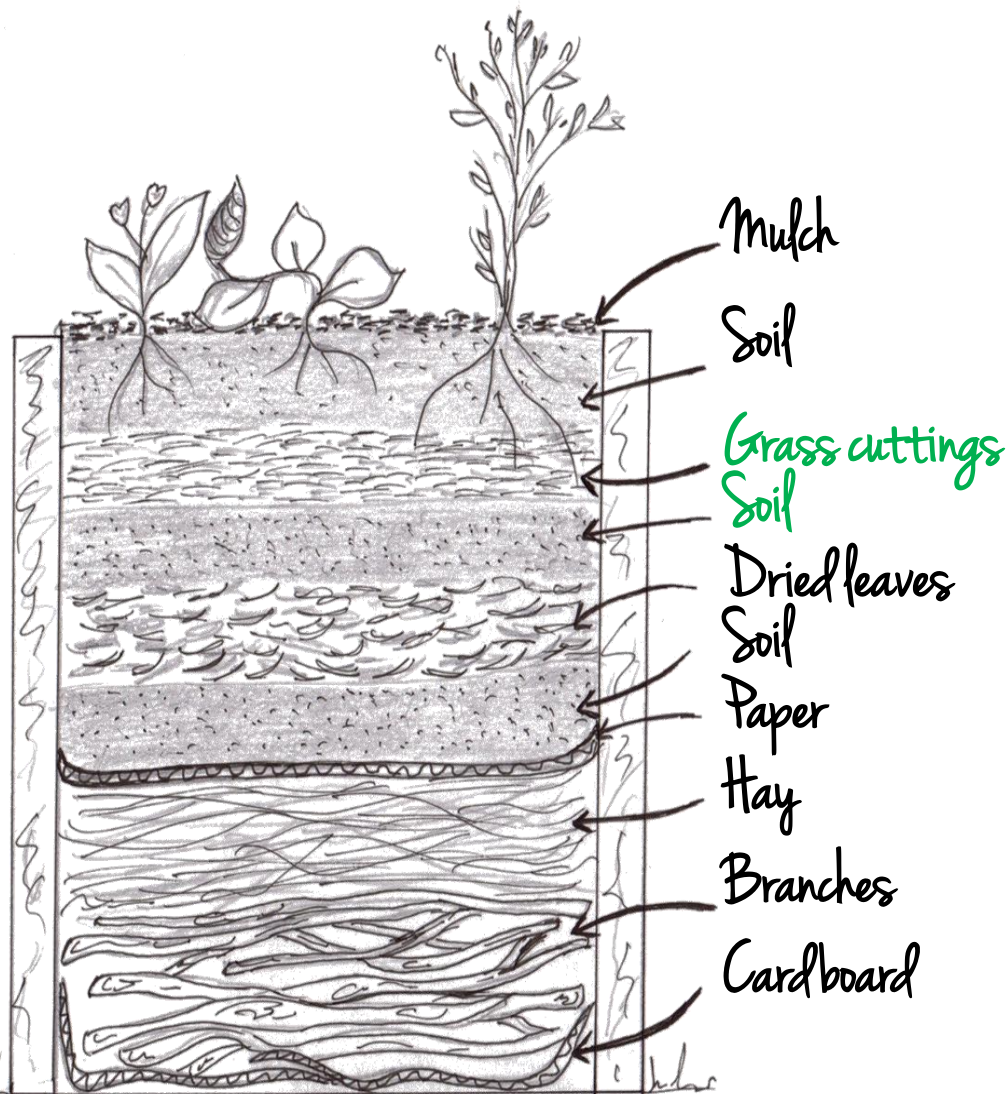


5. A layer of soil and then dried leaves



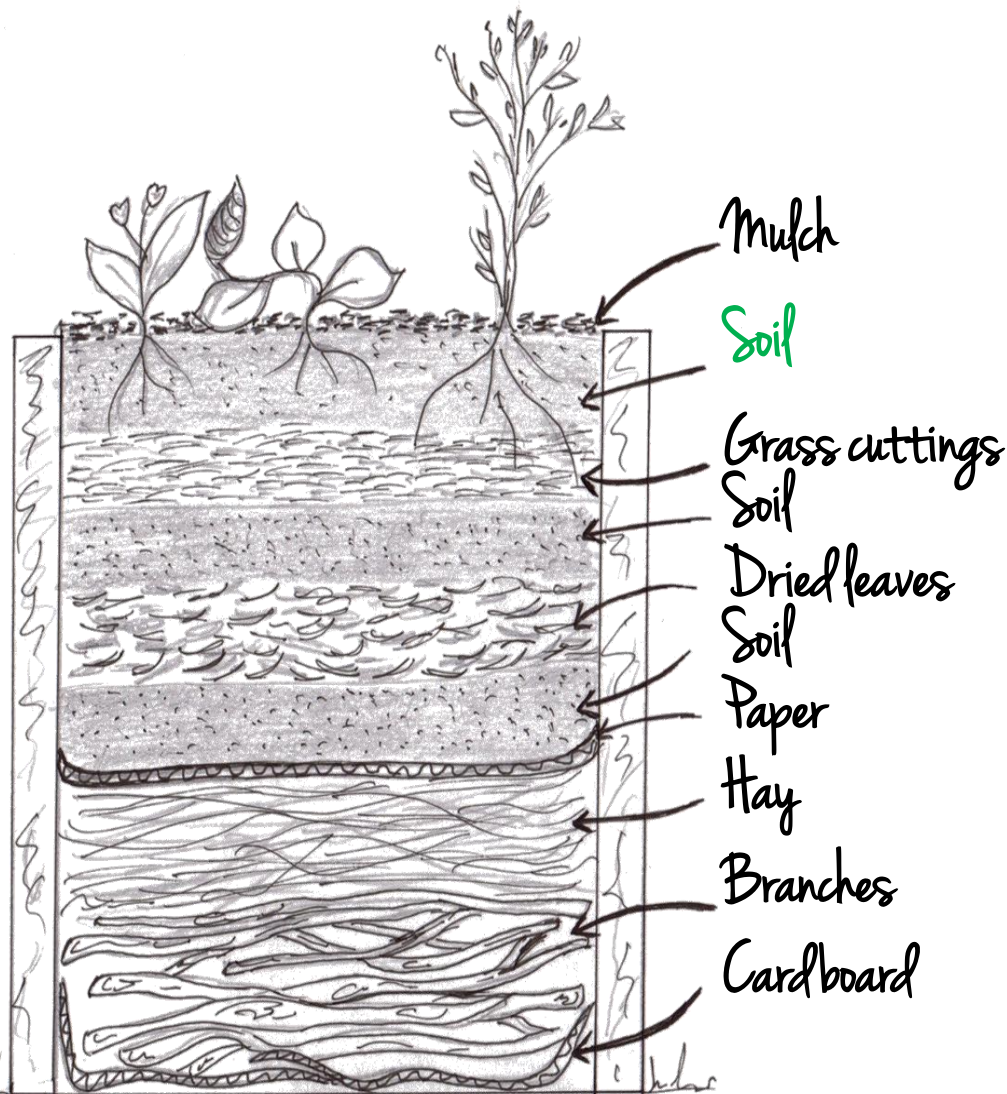
